

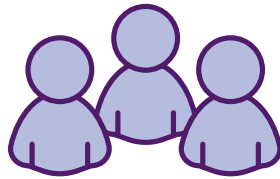
# The health and wellbeing of the LGBTIQ+ population in Victoria

Findings from the Victorian Population Health Survey 2017

A significantly **higher** proportion of LGBTIQ+ adults:



were born in Australia



are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people



had never married



were not able to raise \$2,000 within two days in an emergency



had a total annual household income of less than \$40,000



experienced food insecurity in the previous year.

A significantly **lower** proportion of LGBTIQ+ adults:



were currently covered by private health insurance



were married or living with a partner



had a total annual household income of \$100,000, or more.

Please note that only statistically significant differences are presented for the measures listed above.
